Water Management

The Hotel Windsor has been implementing various steps towards the reduction of water wastage. Some of the steps taken are:

- Installed water saving shower heads in all guest rooms
- All guest and public toilets have dual flush cisterns
- Signs placed in guest bathrooms to encourage reusing of towels
- Kitchen hand-wash basins have taps that automatically turn off after a certain amount of time
- Main dishwasher has been upgraded to ensure maximum water efficiency
- Continued guest and employee awareness
- The Engineering Department monitors water usage on an ongoing basis.

Waste Management

- Paper products, cans, bottles and cardboard are recycled
- All guest rooms and offices have been provided with recycling bins
- Used cooking oil is collected by an external supplier and recycled for use as an alternate fuel source
- Double-sided printing is set as default on all printers across the hotel
- The hotel regularly promotes the message of not printing unless required, and soft copy distribution is encouraged where possible
- Printer cartridges are collected for recycling.

Energy Management

- The Engineering Department monitors electricity and gas usage on an ongoing basis
- Replacement of all light globes in the guest rooms to energy efficient globes
- Lights and air conditioning in rooms kept on only if the room is a stay-over or check-in is pending
- Lights in corridors switch to alternate between the hours of 1am and 5.30am
- Televisions are not kept on standby to conserve energy.
