### Water Management

Etihad Stadium has recently initiated a project that will see the venue reduce its water usage. The project, which is co-funded with City West Water, involves large water tanks that catch storm water from the stadium's retractable roof, which is then used in toilets throughout levels one and two and in corporate suites.

To further reduce its water usage, Etihad Stadium has installed flow restrictors to 800 taps, installed water efficient shower heads in its change rooms, installed an injection pump in its irrigation system and also uses wetting agents on the playing surface to lock in moisture.

### Waste Management

Etihad Stadium has recycling bins for patrons to utilise throughout the venue.

### Energy Management

The venue entered into a relationship with Australian-based carbon management company, Carbon Planet, in 2008 after receiving 15 lighting rigs that are used to grow and consolidate Etihad Stadium's playing field. Carbon Planet sponsors the lighting rigs and offsets the carbon emissions that they create.

### Projects to be Completed

The company recently undertook an audit of the venue to identify ways in which it could reduce its carbon footprint and become more environmentally responsible.

### Other

Etihad Stadium is committed to being an environmentally aware venue and has initiated many green projects since the stadium's inception in 2000.
